

The sample LSID-22-0261 1477470 Hoosier Crate D21 was found to not conform to the manufacturer submitted benchmark and was analyzed in duplicate to confirm the original scan result, which is our laboratory protocol. The duplicate result matched the original result, thus confirming that this sample does not conform to the manufacturer submitted benchmark sample. I contacted the manufacturer with the date code of the sample and was advised to use Hoosier Crate D21 1293695 as the benchmark tire sample for this tire sample. I have enclosed the tire scan of Hoosier Crate D21 1293695 for comparison with the non-conforming tire sample. I appreciate the opportunity to provide tire analysis for your raceway.
