The sample LSID-20-3373 1477412 Hoosier 1350 was found to not conform to the manufacturer submitted benchmark and was analyzed in duplicate to confirm the original scan result, which is our laboratory protocol. The duplicate result matched the original result, thus confirming that this sample does not conform to the manufacturer submitted benchmark sample. I contacted the manufacturer with the date code for this sample and was advised to use Hoosier 1350 1293648 as the benchmark tire sample for this tire sample. I have enclosed the tire scan of Hoosier 1350 1293648 for comparison with the non-conforming tire sample. I appreciate the opportunity to provide tire analysis for your raceway.
